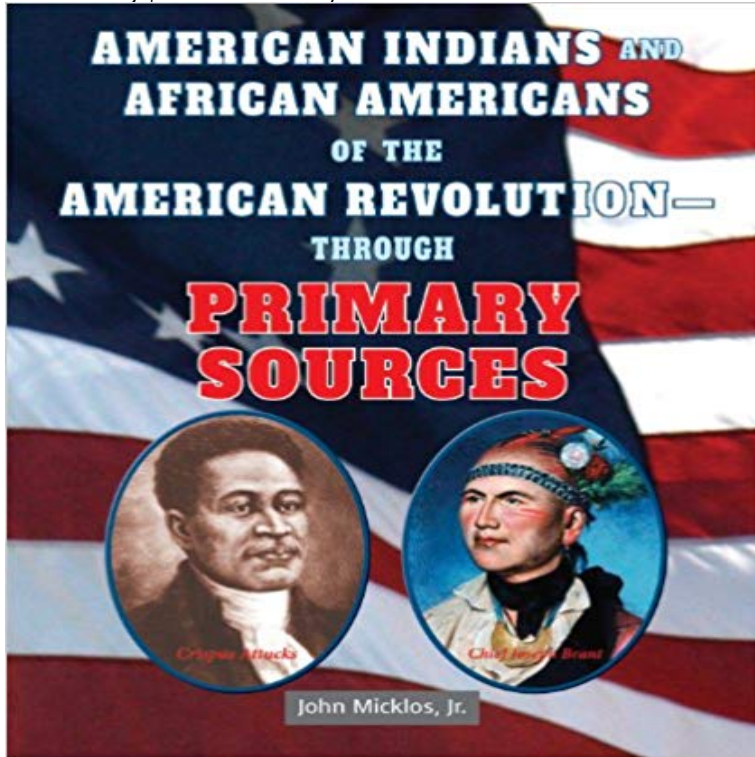


# American Indians and African Americans of the American Revolution - Through Primary Sources
