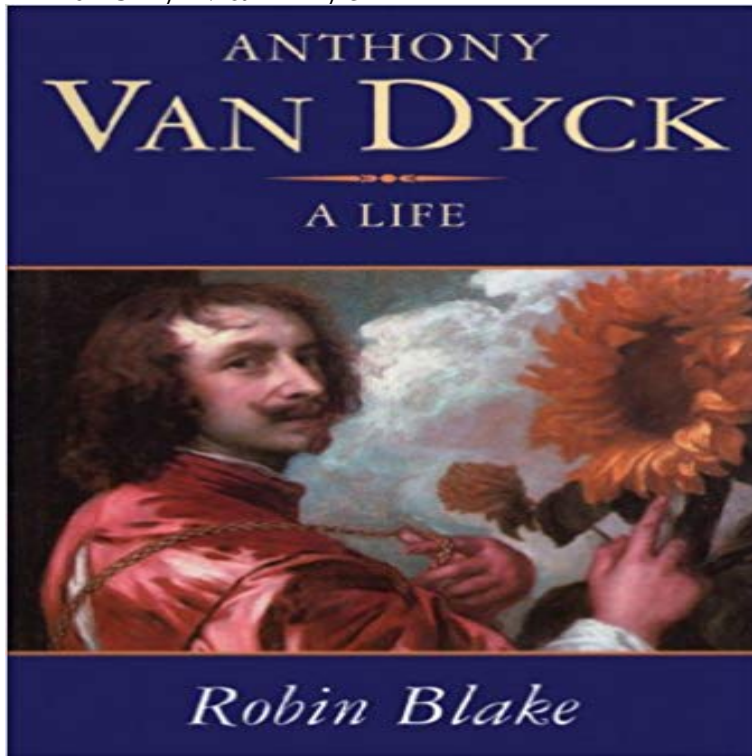


Anthony Van Dyck
