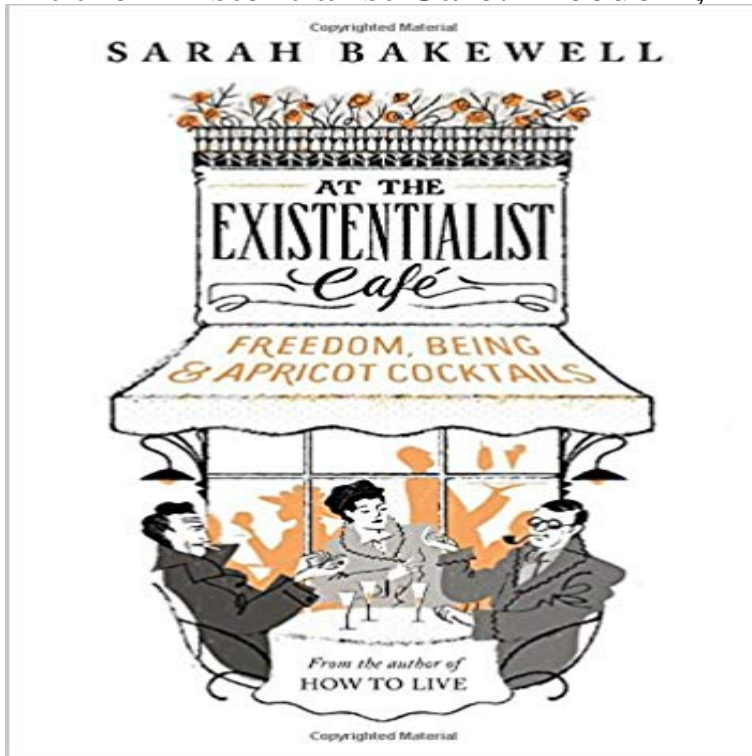


At the Existentialist Cafe: Freedom, Being and Apricot Cocktails
