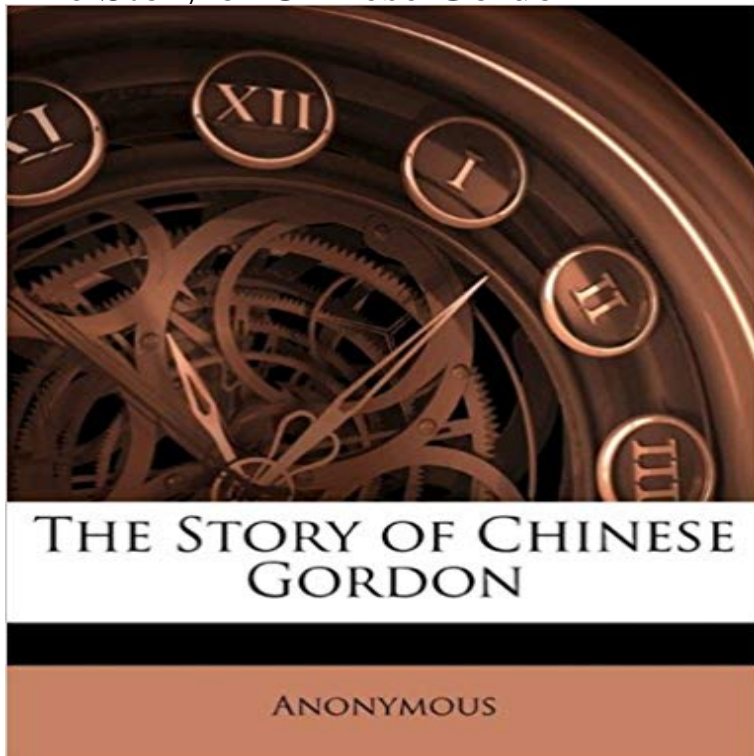


## The Story of Chinese Gordon
