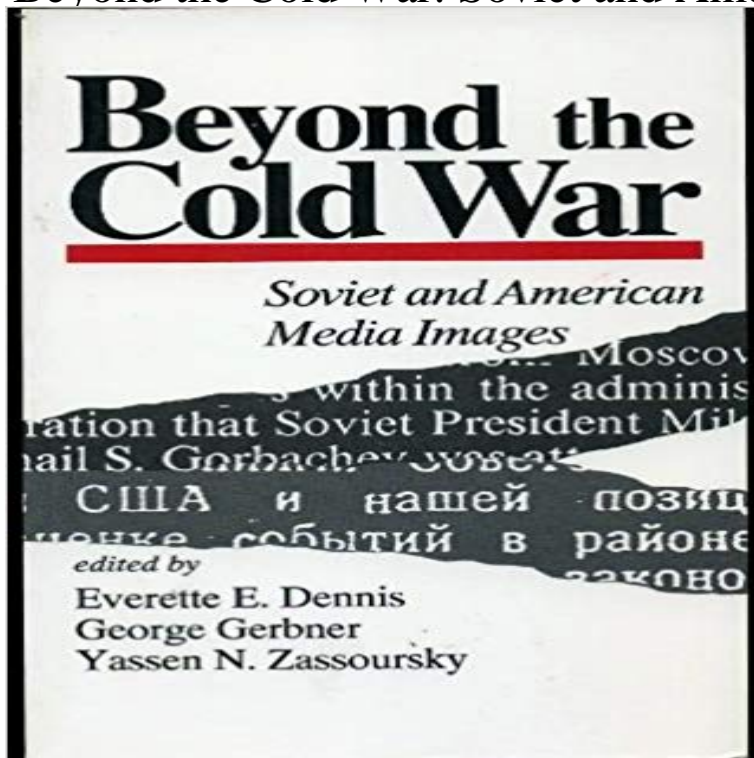


Beyond the Cold War: Soviet and American Media Images
