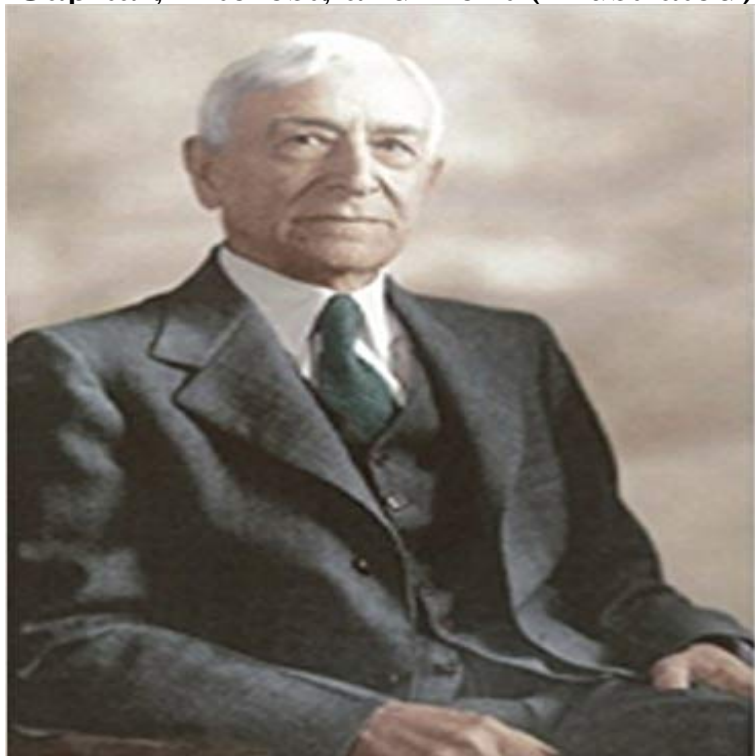


## Capital, Interest, and Rent (Illustrated)
