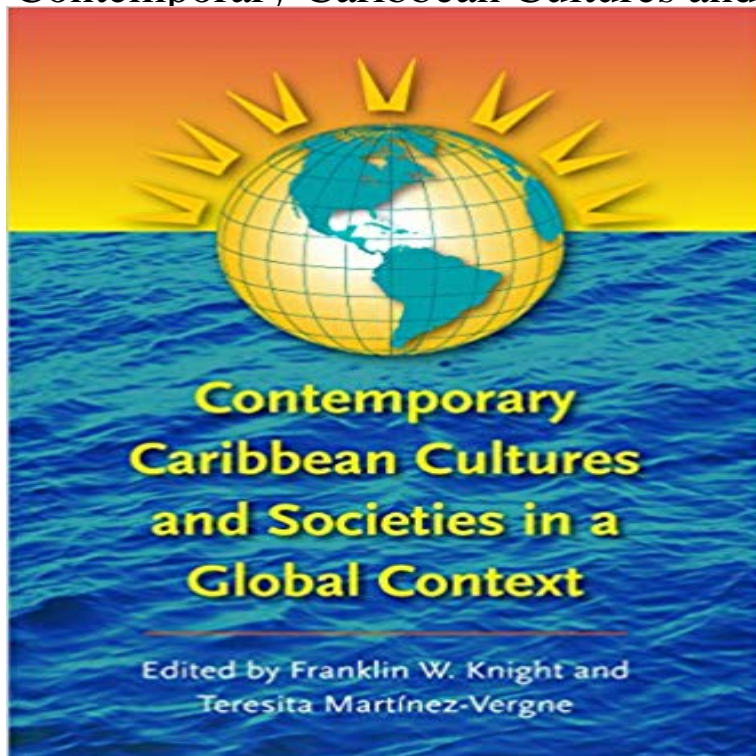


Contemporary Caribbean Cultures and Societies in a Global Context
