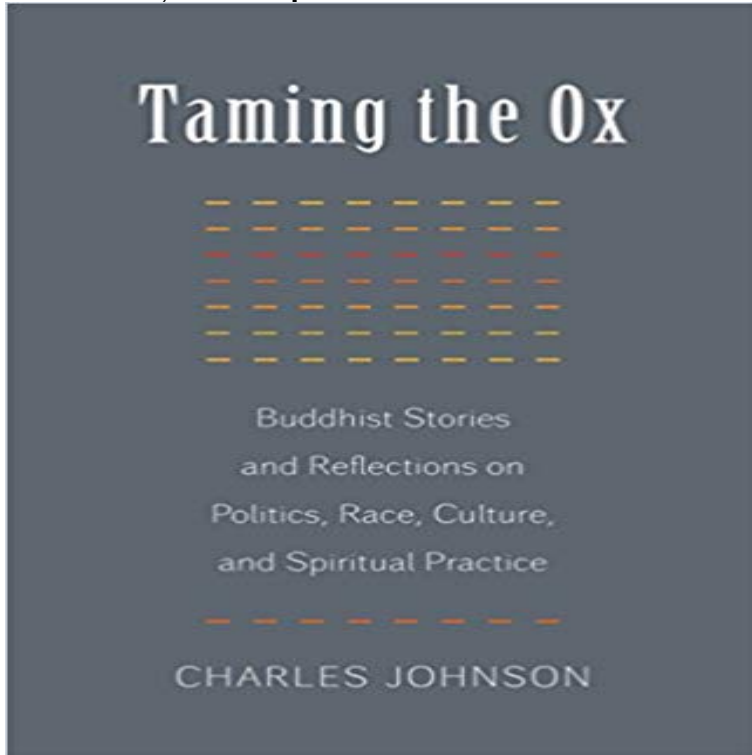


Taming the Ox: Buddhist Stories and Reflections on Politics, Race, Culture, and Spiritual Practice

His work is often philosophically, politically, and spiritually oriented, and he has deeply explored racial issues in the United States, most notably in his novel *Middle Passage*, which won the National Book Award for Fiction in 1990. Johnson received a MacArthur Fellowship, or Genius Grant, in 1998. *Taming the Ox* is a wonderful reflection of what Johnson has learned during his passage through American literature, the visual arts, and the Buddhadharma.
