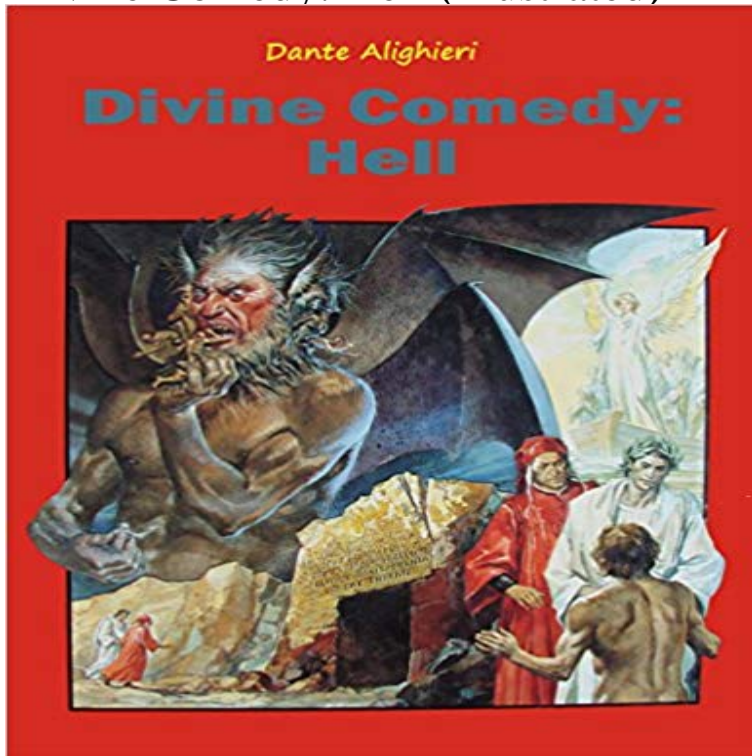


Divine Comedy: Hell (illustrated)



The first part of Dantes Divine Comedy, the Inferno (or Hell) begins on the night before Good Friday in the year 1300, halfway along our lifes path. Dante is thirty-five years old, half of the biblical life expectancy of 70, lost in a dark wood, assailed by beasts he cannot evade, and unable to find the straight way to salvation. Conscious that he is ruining himself and that he is falling into a deep place where the sun is silent, Dante is at last rescued by Virgil, and the two of them begin their journey to the underworld. Each sins punishment in Inferno is a contrapasso, a symbolic instance of poetic justice Includes unique illustrations.
