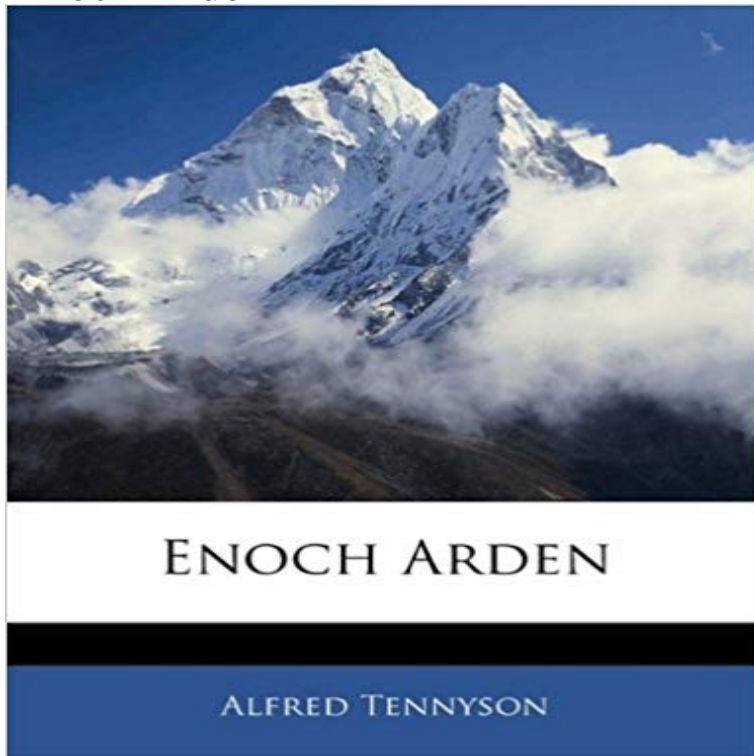


Enoch Arden
