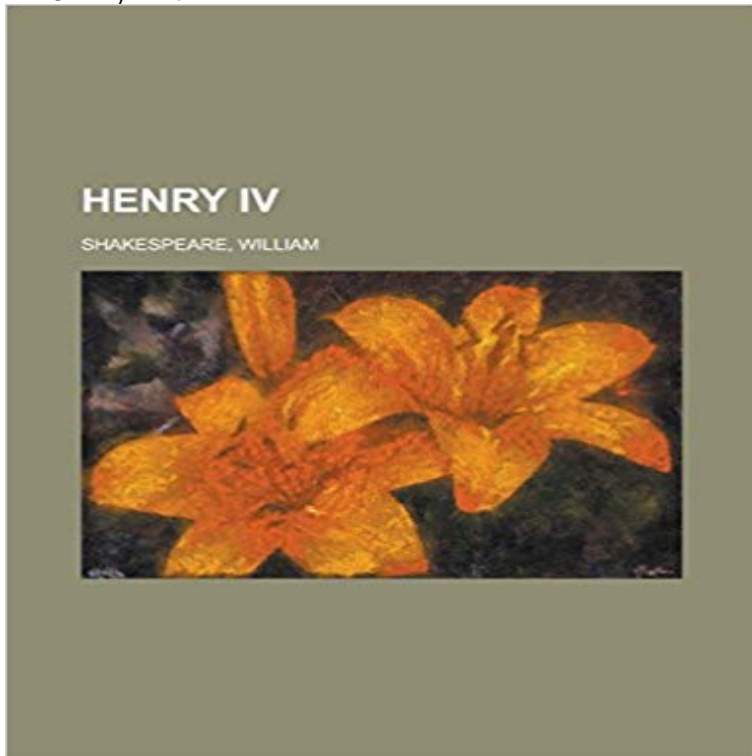


# Henry IV
