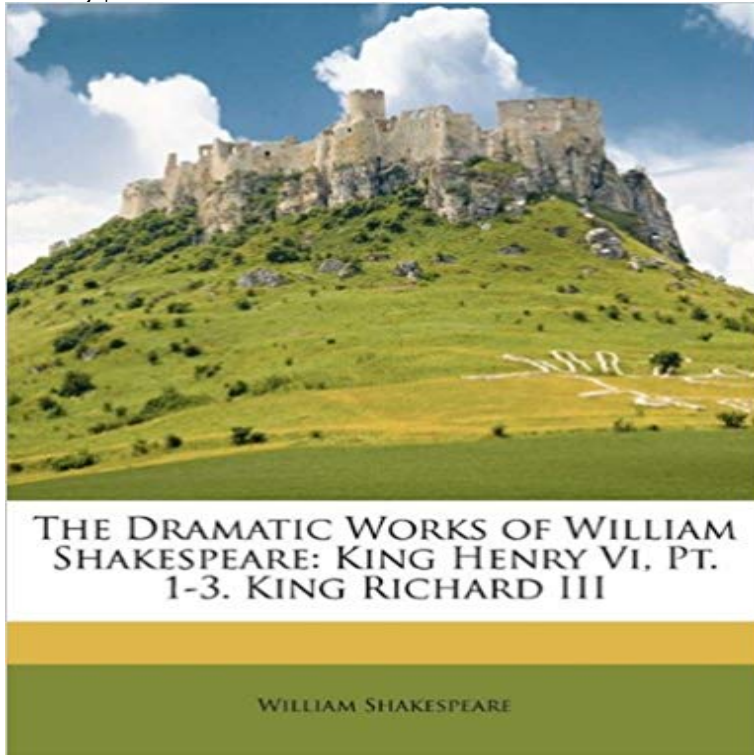


## The Dramatic Works of William Shakespeare: King Henry VI, Pt. 1-3. King Richard III
