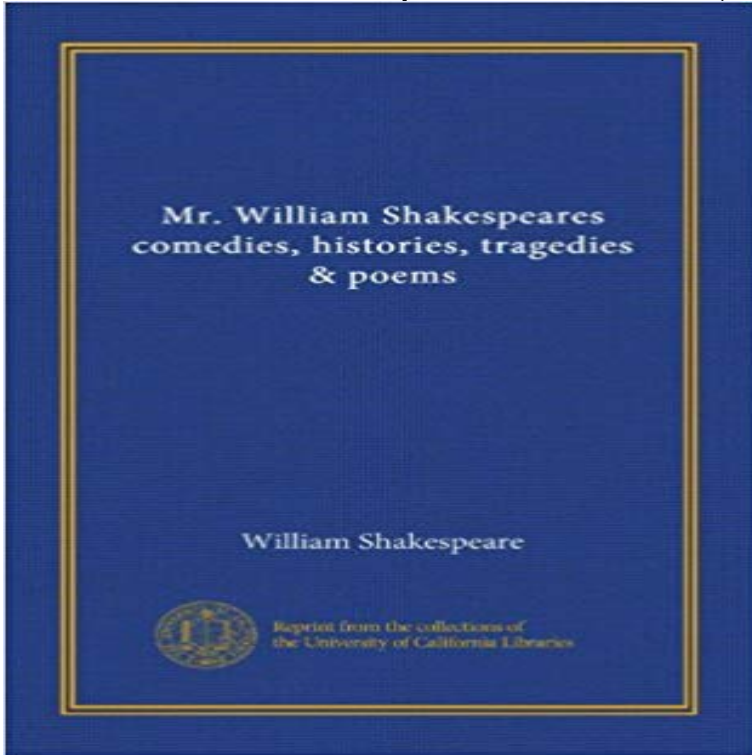


## Mr. William Shakespeares comedies, histories, tragedies & poems (v.06)
