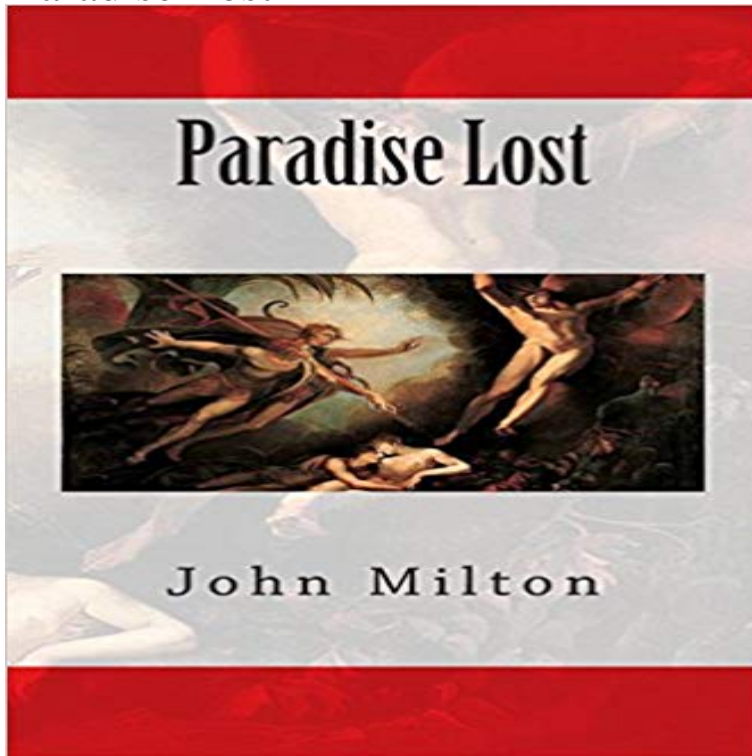


Paradise Lost
