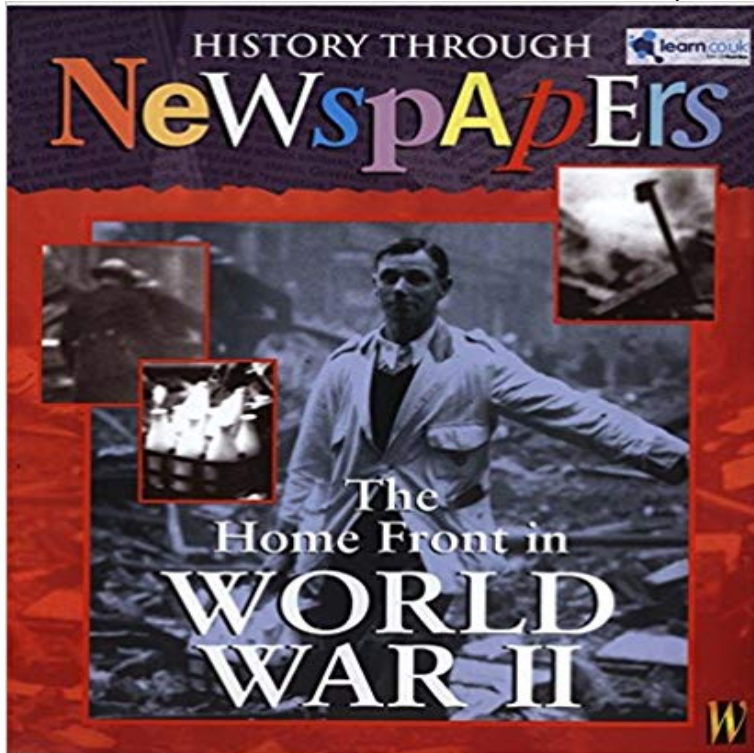


The Home Front in World War II (History Through Newspapers)
