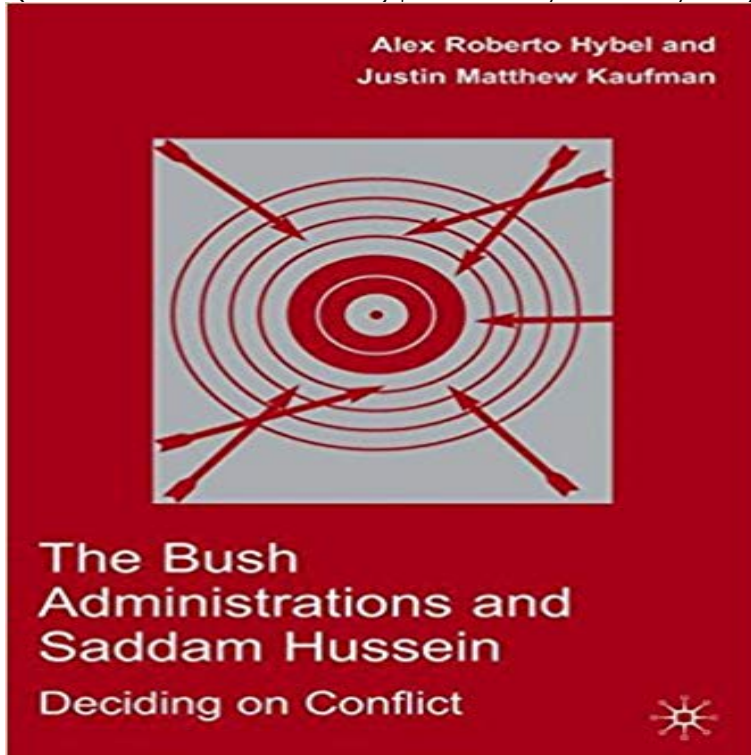


# The Bush Administrations and Saddam Hussein: Deciding on Conflict (Advances in Foreign Policy Analysis)
