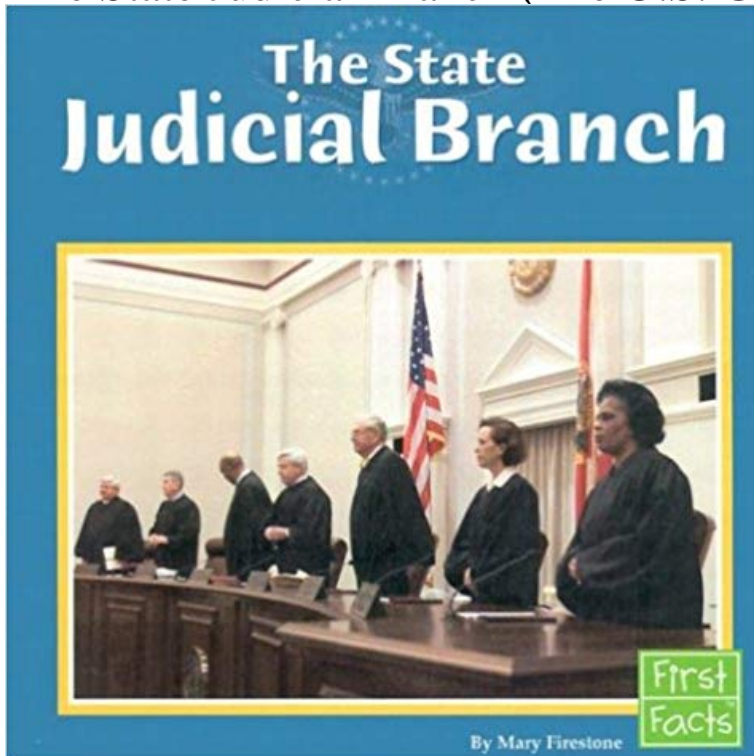


The State Judicial Branch (The U.S. Government)
