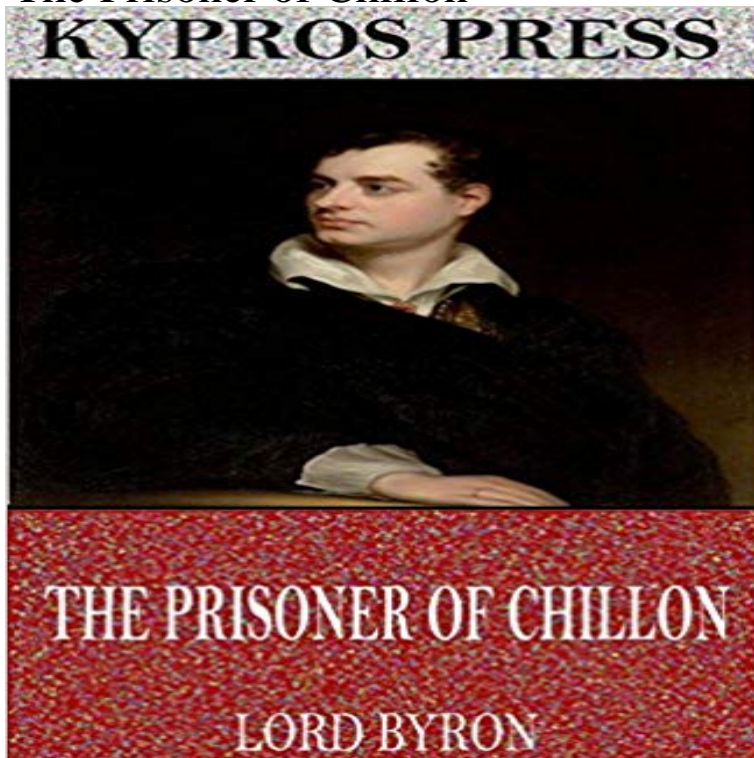


The Prisoner of Chillon
