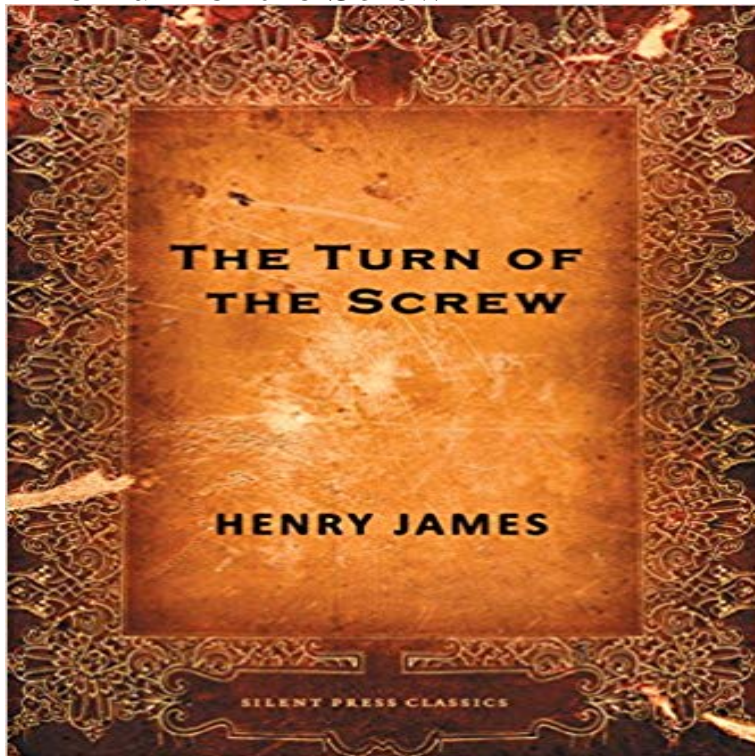


## The Turn of the Screw
