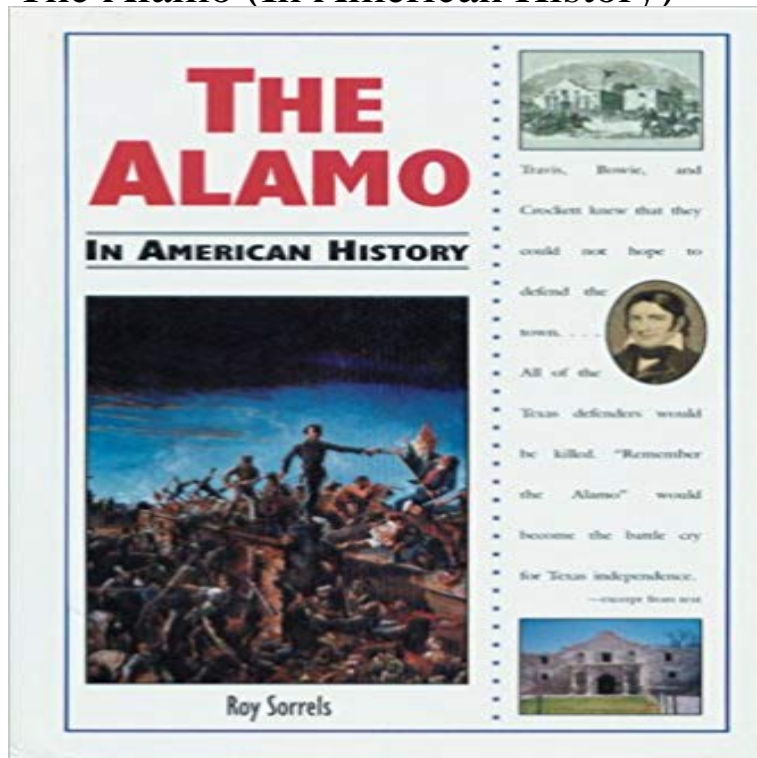


The Alamo (In American History)
